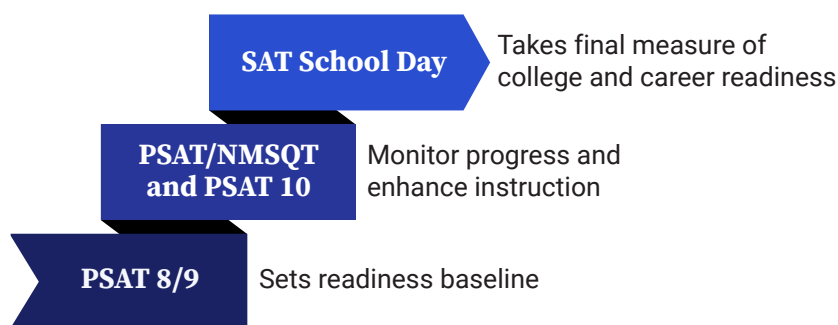

**PSAT™ 8/9** establishes early college and career readiness baselines.





**PSAT™ 10 or PSAT/NMSQT®** measures growth and connects students to practice and scholarship opportunities.
