

PSAT™ 10, given to 10th graders, and PSAT/NMSQT®, given to both 10th and 11th graders, measure the core reading, writing, math, and science skills students need to be ready for college and career. Schools that give PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, and PSAT/NMSQT can monitor students' progress over time, and use results to inform instruction.
